# 2023 Stihl Timerbersports® World Rookie Championships

On Friday 9 June, some of the best Rookie axemen from around the world converged on Rotterdam to compete in the 2023 World Championships. These included our very own 23 year old NSW axeman Curtis Bennett. Curtis didn't disappoint, soaring to an early lead on the world stage, but 18 year old Szymon Groenwald from Poland stepped up a gear finishing strong, posting two World Records in the Single Buck and Underhand. Curtis and New Zealand's Sam Bellamy were the only axemen in a position to threaten Szymon, but even despite a DQ in the Stock Saw the young Pole came out on top.

At these World Championships Curtis broke the Australian Underhand and Stock Saw Rookie records, and posted two personal bests in the Single Buck and Spring Board. Congratulations Curtis.


