AUSTRALIAN TITLES

Points will be awarded for Australian Champion Axeman of the Year.

NSW STATE TITLES

Points are awarded and the NSW Champion of Champion will be the axeman and axewoman with the most points at the end of the title year. Points 1st 5, 2nd 3, 3rd 2, 4th 1. Double handed sawing points will be halved, ie 1st each competitor will receive 2.5 points, and so on.

Note points must be allocated to the **top four placed NSW axemen** in a NSW State Title event. If NSW axemen/women do not finish in the top four, additional places of axemen/women in the title must be advised so points can be allocated.

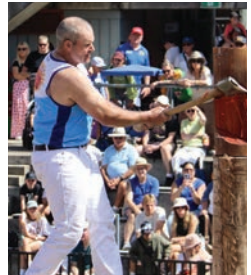

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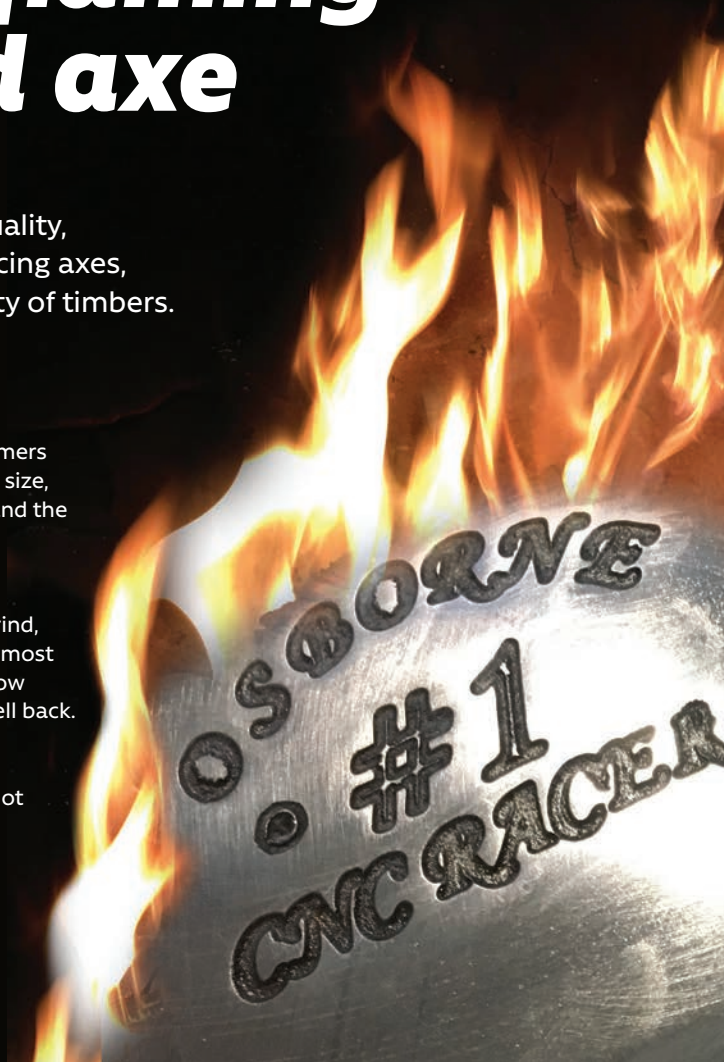
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
