Handicapping, Entries and Wood

The NSWAA is focused on improving the woodchopping experience through ongoing discussions about a statewide handicapping system and enhanced record-keeping. You will also notice streamlined entry processes for some of our associations as we embrace new technology. Our biggest challenge is wood supply; this remains my number one priority.

Sponsorship

Securing sufficient funding remained a persistent challenge. While sponsorship support was strong, increasing costs associated with hosting events highlighted the need for additional resources to sustain and grow the sport. Please contact me directly if you have


